- Your DOT exam must be paid for at the time of your appointment.
- Please bring the following documentation to your appointment:
 - A valid Massachusetts Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) driver's license.
 - (If you are not already an MFM patient ...) A copy of your last physical exam results and/or office visit notes containing medical history.
 - Your current Medical Examination Certificate.
 - A Medical Examination Report. Please fill out the top section of the report before your appointment. Your provider will fill out the rest of the report.
